**Instructions for Adult Scavenger Hunt**

Pre-registration is required and a group of 4 is acceptable. Travel in one car as a team.

Meet at the History Center of Olmsted County to check-in and pick up your first 5 clues.

Open the clues in numbered sequence. Complete clue number one prior to proceeding to clue 2, etc., etc...

Scavenger hunt lasts 3 hours. If you are not done with all of the clues within a 3 hour time frame, it is okay.

The Scavenger hunt is not a race, accuracy is what you are aiming for.

When your team is done with the scavenger hunt or during the scavenger hunt, please submit your photos to the email of [programs@olmstedhistory.com](mailto:programs@olmstedhistory.com). 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be determined from your team's photo submission.

There will be a total of 11 clues per team, some are the same, but most are different.

Clues will take your team around Rochester, MN within the city limits.

Use a **smartphone** to take a picture with your team at each clue.

If you do not solve a clue within 15 minutes, open the next clue.

If your team gets done with all the clues within the 3 hours please feel free to go back to your favorite restraunt/bar and enjoy a drink or appetizer.

Use of smartphone is permissible. IT IS NOT CHEATING!!!

In case your team gets stuck, you can call 507-282-9447.

In your second clue packet, there will be an envelope labeled “**Party**”. Please only open the envelope if your team has not finished all of the scavenger hunt clues.

When your team is done with the Scavenger Hunt, if you have not already, please submit all the photos from the adult scavenger hunt. There will be prizes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. This will also give us a chance to see the pictures you have taken with your clues and a chance for feedback from your team.
